REGINA: As the Court of Appeal prepares to hear the Reference by the Government of Saskatchewan in the matter of *The Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act* (sometimes popularly referred to as the Carbon Tax Reference), members of the public are advised that they can watch a livestream of the Reference on most major media channels.

The CBC, on behalf of a consortium of media partners, applied for and received leave from the Court to broadcast the hearing live.

“This appeal has generated widespread interest across the province, and indeed the country,” Chief Justice Robert G. Richards said. “We hope that livestreaming will help the public to better understand both the legal issues at stake and the hearing process.”

Counsel for the various parties will fill the entire courtroom on the second floor of the Victoria Avenue Court House in Regina. However, members of the public and media who are at the court house will be able to watch via video-link from a nearby courtroom.
