

## ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

## Chamber Applications and Pre-Trial Conferences pursuant to The Child and Family Services Act

- 1. Effective September 1, 2018, the scheduling of child protection chambers and pre-trial conferences will be changed in the Judicial Centre of Saskatoon so that it will become the same as the current practice in the Judicial Centre of Regina.
- 2. The scheduling of child protection chambers and pre-trial conferences in the Judicial Centres of Regina and Prince Albert will remain the same.
- 3. The scheduling for these three judicial centres will be as follows:
  - Regina and Saskatoon
    - child protection chambers and pre-trial conferences will continue to be held on Tuesdays, as published in the Saskatchewan Gazette;
    - all child protection chamber matters, both first appearance and subsequent appearances, will be set to commence at 10:00 a.m.;
    - child protection pre-trial conferences will follow and be set to commence at either:
      - 11:00 a.m.
      - 1:00 p.m., or
      - **2:00** p.m.

## - Prince Albert

- child protection chambers and pre-trial conferences will continue to be held on Mondays, as published in the Saskatchewan Gazette;
- all child protection chamber matters, both first appearances and subsequent appearances, will be set to commence at 2:00 p.m.;

• child protection pre-trial conferences (usually no more than two) will follow and will be set to commence at 2:30 p.m.
