ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

Chamber Applications and Pre-Trial Conferences pursuant to *The Child and Family Services Act*

1. Effective September 1, 2018, the scheduling of child protection chambers and pre-trial conferences will be changed in the Judicial Centre of Saskatoon so that it will become the same as the current practice in the Judicial Centre of Regina.
2. The scheduling of child protection chambers and pre-trial conferences in the Judicial Centres of Regina and Prince Albert will remain the same.
3. The scheduling for these three judicial centres will be as follows:

- Regina and Saskatoon


- child protection chambers and pre-trial conferences will continue to be held on Tuesdays, as published in the Saskatchewan Gazette;
- all child protection chamber matters, both first appearance and subsequent appearances, will be set to commence at 10:00 a.m.;
- child protection pre-trial conferences will follow and be set to commence at either:
 - 11:00 a.m.
 - 1:00 p.m., or
 - 2:00 p.m.

- Prince Albert

- child protection chambers and pre-trial conferences will continue to be held on Mondays, as published in the Saskatchewan Gazette;
- all child protection chamber matters, both first appearances and subsequent appearances, will be set to commence at 2:00 p.m.;

- child protection pre-trial conferences (usually no more than two) will follow and will be set to commence at 2:30 p.m.
