RE: Amendments to The Court of Appeal Rules

Effective July 1, 2014, the Court of Appeal for Saskatchewan amended its civil rules, forms and practice directives. A consolidated version of *The Court of Appeal Rules* is available on the Court's website at www.sasklawcourts.ca

Some highlights of the amendments are:

- updated references in the rules to *The Queen's Bench Rules* to reflect the July 1, 2013 changes to *The Queen's Bench Rules*.
- changes to Rule 21 to incorporate the portion of Civil Practice Directive No. 3 relating to transcripts, confirming that a *praecipe* is no longer required.
- specific inclusion of a 3 clear day time period for service of a notice of motion prior to Chambers and codification of existing practices for the service and filing of other application material prior to Chambers.
- incorporation of Civil Practice Directive No. 4 relating to taxation and inclusion of a complete taxation process.
- incorporation of Civil Practice Directive No. 5 relating to the use of a Certificate of Service.
