NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

January 24, 2019

Members of the public planning to attend the sentencing hearing for Jaskirat Singh Sidhu scheduled to begin Monday in Melfort should keep in mind the following:

- It is a court proceeding. The Kerry Vickar Centre is deemed a court house for the purpose and duration of the hearing, and proper court decorum will be expected and enforced at all times and in all areas of the building.
- The main entrance will be the only public entrance to the facility. There will be airport-style security screening in place immediately within. You will have to empty your pockets and remove your belt and outside coat. The less you bring, the faster the process.
- The following are not permitted:
  - a. large bags and backpacks;
  - b. food or water, including water bottles;
  - c. cameras or recording equipment of any kind; and
  - d. knives, scissors, sticks, bats, bottles, or any item that may be deemed a possible threat.
- Cell phones must be turned off in the courtroom area, and members of the public are not permitted to use a phone for any purpose within the courtroom while court is proceeding.
- Hats, toques, etc. must be removed in the courtroom.
- There is absolutely no talking allowed while court is proceeding. If you must enter or exit while court is proceeding, do so quietly.

Deputy Sheriffs, supported by members of the RCMP, will be present to ensure the hearing proceeds in a manner befitting its solemn and serious nature.
