ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

Insolvency and Commercial Template Orders

This Notice replaces the Administrative Notices issued December 20, 2017 and September 10, 2019.

In June 2006, the Court of Queen's Bench endorsed a template receivership order for counsel's use in matters before the Court pursuant to Civil Practice Directive No. 2, Bankruptcy and Insolvency. In June 2008, the Court endorsed a template initial order under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*. As a result of legislative changes and developments in the law, further revisions to these template orders were endorsed by the Court on December 6, 2017.

Two additional template orders pertaining to court-appointed receivers were endorsed by the Court on June 5, 2019. In addition, the Court endorsed template interim and final orders for plans of arrangement pursuant to s. 186.1 of *The Business Corporations Act* and s. 192 of the *Canada Business Corporations Act* on December 5, 2019.

The template orders have been prepared by the Insolvency Section of the Canadian Bar Association, Saskatchewan Branch, working in consultation with the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Panel of the Court.

All template orders are attached to this Administrative Notice. The Table of Contents provides a hyperlink to each of the documents.

Any counsel who intends to apply to the Court for relief is directed to utilize these template orders, and to advise the presiding judge of any additions or changes to those orders by way of highlighting in bold letters or blacklining. While the discretion of any presiding judge is unfettered by the use of these template orders, it is expected that any draft orders presented by counsel in an application will be substantially in compliance with the template orders.
