Due to forest fires threatening the La Ronge community, regular court proceedings for La Ronge and the outlying communities served by the La Ronge Court House have been cancelled for the week of Monday, July 6. The La Ronge judges will, however, be holding court proceedings for the affected communities from the Prince Albert Provincial Court House. Where possible, the affected communities will be connected to Prince Albert by either telephone link or video-conference link.
