

ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

Reopening of Weyburn Judicial Centre

With the establishment of Weyburn as a judicial centre of the Court of King's Bench, the Registry Office located in the Court House at 301 Prairie Avenue in Weyburn, Saskatchewan will open on April 3, 2023.

Location of Actions

New actions and proceedings may be commenced in the Judicial Centre of Weyburn on or after April 3, 2023.

Actions from any other judicial centre may be transferred to the Judicial Centre of Weyburn on application in accordance with section 22 of *The Queen's Bench Act, 1998*, SS 1998, c Q-1.01.

Actions transferred from Weyburn to Estevan pursuant to the Administrative Notice issued on December 8, 2016, shall continue in the Judicial Centre of Estevan unless the Court otherwise directs or an application is made pursuant to section 22 of *The Queen's Bench Act*, 1998.

The following chamber sittings are available for actions commenced or transferred to the Judicial Centre of Weyburn:

- Regular Chambers 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 27, 2023; Thursday, August 31, 2023; Tuesday, November 7, 2023; Tuesday, December 12, 2023; Tuesday, January 16, 2024; Tuesday, February 13, 2024; Tuesday, March 12, 2024; Tuesday, April 9, 2024; Tuesday, May 7, 2024; and Tuesday, June 11, 2024.
- Regular Chambers at 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 10, 2023.

Parties should be aware that no application will be scheduled to be heard in Weyburn before the first scheduled Chambers date of July 27, 2023. If it is anticipated that a hearing will be needed before July 27, 2023, parties may consider commencing the matter in another

judicial centre or delaying the transfer of the action to Weyburn.

Applications made without notice in respect of a Weyburn action may be filed at the Judicial Centre of Weyburn on or after April 3, 2023.
