

## PROTOCOL FORM OF ADDRESS AND PRONOUNS FOR COURT PARTICIPANTS

Provincial Court of Saskatchewan invites counsel, self-represented individuals and witnesses to identify their manner of address (for example, Mr, Ms, Mx, Counsel) and/or pronouns (for example, she/her, he/him, they/them).

Counsel, self-represented individuals and witnesses may contact the Court Manager in writing, including email, in advance of the Court proceeding, advising of their manner of address. Alternatively, counsel, self-represented individuals and witnesses can advise the Court Clerk of their pronouns and titles just prior to the proceeding. Court participants may also advise of the correct pronouns and titles of other individuals attending Court in relation to their proceeding (for example, witnesses) if they have knowledge of this.
