ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

Canada Post Strike

Due to the ongoing Canada Post strike, the Provincial Court is making the following changes to document and cheque distribution:

- Effective immediately, no documents or cheques will be mailed.
- Individuals may contact the Provincial Court offices to make arrangements for in-person pick up of documents or cheques.
- Individuals attending a Provincial Court office for in-person pick up of a cheque will be required to provide government issued photo identification and sign a written acknowledgement of receipt.
- Any documents or cheques that are not picked up at the Provincial Court offices during the strike will be sent out by mail when the Canada Post strike is resolved.

Further, parties and legal counsel should not attempt to serve or file any documents by mail and should review applicable legislation for other approved methods of service, such as personal service, by fax or by email.

These changes are effective immediately and will continue until the Canada Post strike is resolved, or until further written notice is issued.
