

ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

Canada Post Strike

Due to the ongoing Canada Post strike, the Court of King's Bench for Saskatchewan will be making adjustments to document and cheque distribution to minimize disruptions and to ensure timely access to court materials to the greatest extent possible. However, delays are expected.

Effective immediately, no documents will be mailed by the Court of King's Bench for Saskatchewan until the strike is resolved. Where possible, parties will be contacted by telephone or email to arrange in-person pickup of cheques and other court-issued documents, including notices of hearing, grants in estate matters and divorce certificates. Please be prepared to produce photo identification when picking up cheques and other court-issued documents.

Further, where possible, copies of documents will also be sent via email or fax, with originals to follow upon resolution of the strike.

Parties and legal counsel should also refrain from filing documents via mail until the strike is resolved. To ensure timely processing, documents should be filed via other approved methods, such as in-person, by courier or by fax.
