
Child and Family Services Chambers Procedure Change -- Judicial Centre of Prince Albert

Effective January 12, 2026, the procedure for Child and Family Services Chambers in the Judicial Centre of Prince Albert will, subject to the direction of the presiding Chambers Judge, change as follows:

- Each case will be addressed individually, one at a time, with only the parents, parties, caregivers and individuals directly connected to the file present in the courtroom while the matter is heard.
- All others not directly connected to the file being heard will remain outside the courtroom until their case is called.
- After all matters involving attending parents, parties and caregivers have been concluded, the courtroom will then be opened to the rest of the social workers, lawyers and support workers to address any remaining files.

This directive is issued to ensure privacy and efficiency in the handling of Child and Family Services matters.

This Administrative Notice is issued on January 12, 2026.
